ALL ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION OF BIRTH OF CHILD AND A PHOTOCOPY OF EACH DOCUMENT SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO THE LEGALIZATION COUNTER ALONG WITH THE FEES IN CASH ONLY OR SENT BY POST WHEN AN APPLICANT DESIRES TO REGISTER THE NAME OF CHILD, FEES CAN BE MADE BY CROSSED POSTAL ORDER DRAWN IN FAVOUR OF THE HIGH COMMISSION OF INDIA, LONDON.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO REGISTER CHILD.

- 1 Full version Birth Certificate and photocopy.
- 2 Father and mother's valid passports and photocopies (including validity page).
- 3 In case the child is above 1 year but less than 7 years old, an affidavit from the parent stating the reason why the child was not registered for that period and a letter from Home Office stating that the child has not acquired British Citizenship.
- 4 In case the child is 7 years old and above, an affidavit from the parent stating the reason why the child was not registered for the period and a letter from Home Office stating that the child has not acquired British Citizenship. The child will be registered only after receiving clearance from The Government of India.

Note:	for birth registration of a child, names of parents (husband & wife) mentioned in the birth certificate must precisely tally with the names mentioned in the passport.
